Exhibition Categories

- 1. Oil Any two-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses the medium and process of oil painting in 90% or more of the painting. Traditional and water-based oils are included.
- 2. Acrylics Any two-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses the medium and process of acrylic painting in 90% or more of the painting.
- 3. Watercolors Any two-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses the medium and process of watercolor painting in 90% or more of the painting.
- 4. Pastels Any two-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses the medium and process of pastel painting in 90% or more of the painting. Soft and oil-based pastels are included.
- 5. Graphics Any two-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and primarily uses drawing as the process. This includes etchings; drawings using graphite, pen/ink, charcoal, crayon, colored pencil, and original prints.
- 6. Mixed Media Any two-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses a significant amount of two or more mediums.
- 7. Photography Any two-dimensional photograph that hangs on the wall and, either captured digitally or traditionally (and developed as film prints), uses the medium and process of traditional photography. Photographs in this category must only have standard modifications, e.g., cropping, shading, tinting, minor color adjustments, etc.
- 8. Digital Art Any two-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and was primarily created, modified or assembled using the computer or other electronic tools. The category includes photographs that have been significantly altered digitally.
- 9. Sculpture Any original three-dimensional work that does not hang on the wall.

Eligibility

- Westchester residents, 18 years old or older, may enter.
- Only original work, not older than three years will be accepted.
- Last year's Blue Ribbon winners are eligible to enter the show. If they choose to enter their artwork in the *same* category that they won First Place in *last year*, that artwork will be marked, "Not in Competition." However, after a year they may return to the same category. Last year's winners are strongly encouraged to enter new categories this year.

Requirements

- Entries must be submitted on Monday, October 15th between 4 8 p.m. at the Woman's Club of White Plains.
- Artists may submit up to *three* works in any category.
- An entry fee of \$10 for each piece of artwork must be paid by check (made payable to the Woman's Club of White Plains Foundation) or by cash on the 16th.
- The attached application form must also be completed and submitted on the 15th.
- Artists must agree that their entries will remain until the end of the reception on October 18th. The artwork will be handled with all possible care, however, the Woman's Club of White Plains will not be responsible for loss or damage to work submitted.
- The maximum size of artwork, including frame, is 35" by 45" and <u>all pictures must be wired for</u> <u>hanging</u>.

Prizes

Art work will be judged by a panel of three judges on Tuesday, October 16th. Ribbons will be presented to artists at a reception held at the culmination of the Art Show on Thursday, October 18th. This year's Blue Ribbon winners, are invited to participate in the Beaux Arts competition finale at the Bronxville Woman's Club in July of 2019. Please note: If a first prize has been won in a particular category at this show, the artist may NOT compete in that category in any other Beaux Arts Show except the finale in July. They may enter their artwork in a different category in other shows.

Sale of Artwork

If an artist wishes to offer her/his artwork for sale, it should be indicated on the application form that is attached to this flyer. The amount listed should include a 20% commission for the Woman's Club of White Plains. For example, if an artist indicates on the application form that he would like to sell a painting for \$200, the artist will receive \$160 and the Woman's Club, \$40. The buyer will pay the Woman's Club of White Plains Foundation (a 501(c)3 organization) and the Club will send a check to the artist for the artwork.
