Dutch artist Lisette Overweel creates mixed-media paintings from her home studio in White Plains, New York. Lisette's work is inspired by nature, dancers, cityscapes, and animals. Her colorful paintings have been featured in many art shows in the Netherlands, Germany, and the United States.
