ELIGIBILITY: Open to all artists and photographers ages 18+ with original artwork created by the artist. Judging will be in two sections: professional and amateur.

SALE: You may choose to sell your work during the Exhibition. It is subject to a 20% commission. All commissions will be going to the BWC, a not for profit 501(c)3 organization. Remittance for the full price should be made payable to the BWC. The Club will mail payment to the artist after all transactions are completed.

CATEGORY	DESCRIPTION	NUMBERING
Oil	Any 2-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses the medium and process of oil painting in 90% or more of the painting. Traditional and water- based oils are included in this category.	000-099
Acrylic	Any 2-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses the medium and process of acrylic painting in 90% or more.	100-199
Watercolor	Any 2-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses the medium and process of watercolor painting in 90% or more.	200-299
Pastels	Any 2-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses the medium and process of pastel painting in 90% or more. Soft and oil-based pastels are included in this category.	300-399
Graphic	Any 2-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and primarily uses drawing as the process. This includes etchings and drawings using graphite, pen/ink, charcoal, crayon, colored-pencil, and original prints.	400-499
Mixed Media	Any 2-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and uses a significant amount of two or more mediums.	500-599
Photography	Any 2-dimensional photograph that hangs on the wall is either captured digitally or traditionally developed as film prints and uses the medium and process of traditional photography. Photographs in this category must only have standard modifications such as cropping, shading, tinting, minor color adjustments, etc.	600-699
Digital	Any original 2-dimensional format that hangs on the wall and primarily created, modified, or assembled using the computer or other electronic tools. The category includes photographs that have been significantly altered digitally.	700-799

LIMITATIONS: 2-dimensional artwork may not exceed 40" in any direction including the frame and <u>must be</u> wired securely for hanging. All entries must remain throughout the entire exhibition.

DESIGNATION OF AMATEUR OR PROFESSIONAL is at the discretion of the artist.

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SELECTION PROCESS: The April 78th Beaux Arts Exhibition & Competition will be awarding "Best in Show" for amateur and professional artists representing all categories. With limited wall space, selections will be based on dimensions and category. Before the delivery date of the artwork, we will contact all artists regarding their status for the April show. Artists who will not be in the April show will be first in line for our November 2024 show.

<u>ARTWORK must not exceed 40" in either direction including the framing.</u> <u>Sturdy wires are</u> <u>mandatory</u>. To hang your piece flat against the wall and not lean forward, please attach wires to the <u>UPPER part of the frame</u>, not near the center. Include a label on the back of the artwork in the <u>lower left corner</u> with your NAME, PHONE, TITLE, and PRO or AMATEUR. Contact the Chair with any questions.

<u>APPLICATION FEE</u>: <u>\$45 payable to the Bronxville Women's Club for each artwork and limited to</u> <u>two (2) pieces.</u> Your donation is tax deductible.

<u>SUBMISSION DELIVERY</u>: Mail or deliver your completed submission documents, including your check and photo(s) of your artwork, to The Bronxville Women's Club by <u>Monday, April 1, 2024</u>, from 10am – 2pm or by appointment.
