### **CLASS POLICIES AND REGISTRATION**

These policies are established to ensure the quality of the program and the safety of all persons attending class.

### Food and Drink Policy

All students should eat breakfast before each class; however, students can bring snacks and drinks so long as eating and drinking do not interfere with the learning and creative process for them or their fellow students. ALL FOOD MUST BE ALLERGY FREE. All drinks must have lids on them. Water is preferred. A spilled drink can disrupt the experience for one or more students. All students must be polite, clean up after themselves, keep the room clean, and follow instructions for disposing of food waste.

### **Device Policy**

Students are allowed to bring mobile phones, but they should only use them at times specified by the teacher. As a parent/legal guardian, please inform your child/student that using a mobile device to take photos, text family or friends, and access apps like Instagram, Snapchat, or other social media without the teacher's permission will lead to disciplinary action. All classroom rules and policies apply.

### **Behavior Expectations**

The teacher will review behavior expectations with the students in class. If a student engages in disruptive behavior that interferes with learning, distracts the teacher, or disrespects the teacher, fellow students, and their property, they will be asked to leave the class. As the parent/legal guardian, please review the behavior policy with your child/student and remind them to follow the teacher's instructions and treat others with courtesy and respect. Please understand that if your child/student fails to do so, they will not be allowed to participate in the program.

### Pick Up/ Child Release Policy

Parents/legal guardians MUST arrange for their child/student pick up within five (5) minutes of the class ending time. There are NO EXCEPTIONS. The teachers and staff cannot and will not be responsible for children when class is over. Students not picked up when the class is over will result in staff contacting your emergency contact. If your emergency contact does not respond, staff will contact Emergency Services.

Ongoing lateness to pick up your child/student may and will affect your child/student's participation in the program..

### Class Attendance & Cancellation Policy

Teachers will keep accurate attendance records for their students. If your child/student happens to be sick, please do not bring them to class. Everyone's safety is of the utmost importance, and we want to avoid the spread of germs through unnecessary contact with an unwell person.

If, for any reason, we have to cancel a class, the teacher will notify parents/legal guardians by phone and/or email.

If, during the program, your child/student no longer wishes to proceed with the dance classes due to a schedule conflict or lack of interest, please notify the staff so we can properly close out the program with your child/student.

### **Acceptance**
